### Early Help Offer

Most families, most of the time, can get on with their lives quite happily with little or no outside help. If they need help it is usually provided by universal services, such as schools. This can include the day to day support provided to children and their families by staff in school. We are very proud of the day to day support our children and families receive at Adlington St. Paul's.

### Focused Pastoral Support

All families can have times, however, when difficulties arise and they either may not recognise it or may not know how to start putting things right. Without the right support early on, situations can get worse very quickly. Schools play a role in supporting families to address these difficulties through more focused pastoral support, which might include bringing in support via an external agency. At St. Paul's, our pastoral support is led by Mrs J Burger (headteacher). Mrs M Crosier, a highly trained ELSA practitioner (Emotional Literacy Support Assistant) provides pastoral support for our children within school. Miss L Taylor also supports families through her work as SENDCO. Mrs J Burger liaises with the Lancashire Early Help Service regularly to ensure our families receive the best support they can.

We are also a bridge school for our Family Hubs Network, which provide a one-stop shop of support and guidance for our families
